Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the above-referenced project. Please consider these comments preliminary.


The Division for Historic Preservation has reviewed this undertaking according to the standards set forth in 36 C.F.R. 800, regulations established by the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation to implement Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act. Project review consists of identifying the project's potential impacts to historic buildings, structures, historic districts, historic landscapes and settings, and known or potential archeological resources.

The proposed grant activities will involve the rehabilitation of houses in the town of Randolph; these activities may impact historic buildings which are listed on or eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places. If your grant application is successful, we will need to execute a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to establish the accepted guidelines for rehabilitating historic structures. Your agreement to follow the terms of that memorandum will satisfy your obligations under the Federal historic preservation regulations.

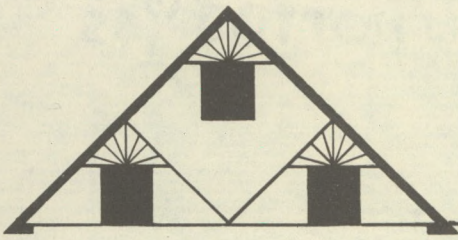
